Avec une pizza aux légumes grillés ou des pâtes au pesto.

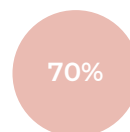

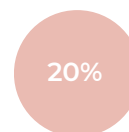

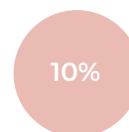

## VINIFICATION

Les vendanges sont mécaniques et effectuées très tôt dans la nuit afin d'obtenir une belle robe pâle. La vinification est traditionnelle et effectuée en cuve inox avec une courte macération pelliculaire. La fermentation alcoolique est thermorégulée et la fermentation malolactique bloquée pour préserver la fraîcheur des arômes.

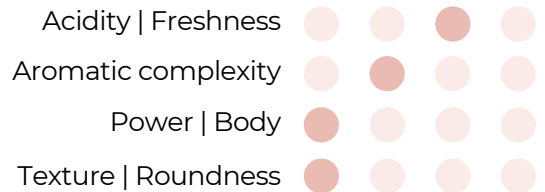

## VINIFICATION

The grapes are mechanically harvested in the early hours of the morning to obtain wine of an attractively pale color. Vinification is performed in the traditional fashion in stainless steel vats with a short period of skin maceration. Fermentation is temperature-controlled and malolactic fermentation is avoided to retain those crisp, fresh aromas.
